Win Sectional Golf Crown

Fliers Do It Again

Clyde high school's golf team has done it again.

The Fliers, who seem to play their best when they're touring a Fremont course, won the sectional championship at Fremont Country Club Friday. It was the second straight year the Fliers have won the event on the par 72, 6,441 yard layout.

And, it was the second straight Friday Coach Jim O'Donnell's Fliers have won a major championship on a Fremont course. Last week they won the Sandusky Bay Championship at Sycamore Hills.

In both instances, the Fliers have had the tourney medalist. At the SBC, it was Jeff McMurtrie, who took the honors. Yesterday Randy Keegan did the trick.

Keegan, who donned a baseball uniform after touring the golf course, carded a five over par 77. It was two strokes better than Fremont St. Joseph's John Faist.

Keegan and Faist qualified for next Friday's district tournament at Heather Downs Club, Toledo. Also in the field will be the top four teams from yesterday's action — Clyde, Fremont Ross, Port Clinton and Tiffin Columbian.

Ross finished nine strokes behind Clyde with a 342. Port Clinton scored a 346 and Tiffin Columbian finished at 357.

McMurtrie was second in the Clyde scoring with an 82. Dave Sanford (85) and Jim Haubert (89) completed the Clyde delegation.

Terry Daily turned in the best round for Ross—82. Not far behind were Bill Moll (84), Kit Kindred (86) and Roger Hart (90).

Daily toured the front nine in two over par, 38. But he had a 44 on the back side. Mll, who was runnerup in the Buckeye Conference meet at Findlay two weeks ago, fired a 45 on the front nine and 39 on the back side.

Dave Hamann's 81 took low honors for Port Clinton. Medalist for Columbian was Bill Mast (84).

Keegan, who's only a junior, put together a 39 and 38. His card on the front side: 745 435 434; back side 444 455 444. The round included one birdie, 13 pars, two bogeys and two double bogeys.

Faist had a 40-30. His card on the front side 546 534 544; back side 435 454 545. The round included three birdies, seven pars, five bogeys and three double bogeys.

The Fremont sectional qualifiers will be joined at Heather Downs by winners from Defiance, Riverby and Chippewa sectionals.
