Mansfield Bumps Ross From Baseball Tourney

Mike Frantz of the Fremont Little Giants pitched himself quite a ball game Wednesday in the Class "AA" District tournament at North Robinson. But he made one

Frantz lost a 4-2 decision to Mansfield but the outcome might have been different except for an umpire's ruling that Frantz, while circling the bases after a two-run homer, failed to touch first base and neither run counted.

Mansfield scored three times in the bottom of the fifth and this rally proved the margin of victory.

Ross threatened in the first when Ken Pasch singled and Russ Hagerly doubled. John Prosser, Jerry Binder, and Jerry Slatter failed to drive in the runs.
