Ross Records First Cross-Country Win

Ross runners finished in the first three spots and six of the first nine Tuesday as the Little Giant cross country team opened with a victory. The Ross harriers outran a young Lakota team, 21-37, at a rerouted Rodger Young course.

Lakota had only one runner returning from last year's Class district championship team. Coach Ron Brant of Ross was pleased because it was his

young runners and not the senior lettermen who carried the Little Giants.

Chuck Boskovich crossed the finish line first in a time of 11:26. Right behind him were Charles Cheek, 11:28, and Mel Huffman, 11:36, both of Ross.
