CROSS COUNTRY TEAM IS PICKED

The Fremont Ross high cross country team will go to Mansfield Saturday for a meet with the high school representatives there, Coach Harold Althoff announced Friday.

Those making the trip will be: Wade Campbell, William Driftmyer, George Mathern, Sam Broshious, James McGrady and Lester Rinebolt.

The schedule is: Oct. 16, Libbey, here; Oct. 19, DeVilbiss, there; Oct. 22, Sandusky, here; Oct. 26, district meet at Toledo; and Nov. 2, state meet at Columbus.

ROSS HARRIERS TAKE FIRST WIN

Coach Harold Althoff's Ross high school cross country team topped Mansfield high school, 26 to 31, in its first match of the fall season Saturday at Mansfield.

Campbell, the Fremont speed merchant, stepped the difficult, rough two mile course in 11 minutes and 22 seconds to take first place. Sawyer and Mayer, Mansfield boys, scored second and third, then Driftmyer, of Fremont, come in fourth.

Others finished as follows: Sawhill, Mansfield, fifth; Mathern, McGrady, Broshious, Fremont, sixth, seventh and eighth; Dochla, Mansfield, ninth; Howell, Reinbolt, Fremont, tenth and eleventh; and Bean, Mansfield, twelfth.

FREMONT HARRIERS BEAT LIBBEY BOYS

Fremont Ross High school's cross-country team defeated the Toledo Libbey High hill and dale squad Wednesday afternoon over the Fremont course by a score of 20 to 35. Wade Campbell, of the Fremont team, finishing first in the event, set a new course record of 10:54.

A teammate, Biz Driftmyer, was a close second. Youngs, placing third, was the first Libbey runner to cross the finish line. The old mark for the high school course was 11:05, set by Grimes of Toledo DeVilbiss. Coach Whitey Althoff will take his Little Giant harriers to Toledo Saturday to run against DeVilbiss High.

ROSS HARRIERS AGAIN VICTORS

Another victory was added to the unbroken string of Fremont Ross High school cross-country team's wins Saturday afternoon at Toledo. The Ross runners defeated the Toledo DeVilbiss High, 18 to 37.

"Soupy" Campbell finished over the two-mile Ottawa Hills course in 10:29.2, breaking that course record as far as DeVilbiss' runners are concerned. The state high school district meet is scheduled to be run over the same course Saturday, with Toledo Scott favored to finish first.
