# Ross Net Squad Eyes Top District Honors

### McConnell Paints A Rosy Picture

Ross high has the makings of one of the best tennis teams in northwestern Ohio.

That's the optimistic opinion of Coach W. J. McConnell, who is hoping for a good break in the weather to get his squad in shape for the opening match with Toledo DeVilbiss April 19.

McConnell's team has three lettermen, Bud Anderson, Dick Garcia and Lonny Price. A freshman, Jack Baron, rated the equal of any of the vets, is almost certain to take over the No. 2 spot in singles.

Last season's team won 10 matches and lost two. The district title was won by DeVilbiss, but one Ross player, Ralph Engle, qualified for the state finals and advanced to the quarter-finals before losing.

#### Working In Gym

The squad is now practicing in the school gymnasium and will move outside as soon as weather permits. McConnell is hoping that the city recreation department will have the new courts at Rodger W. Young Park laid out before long.


