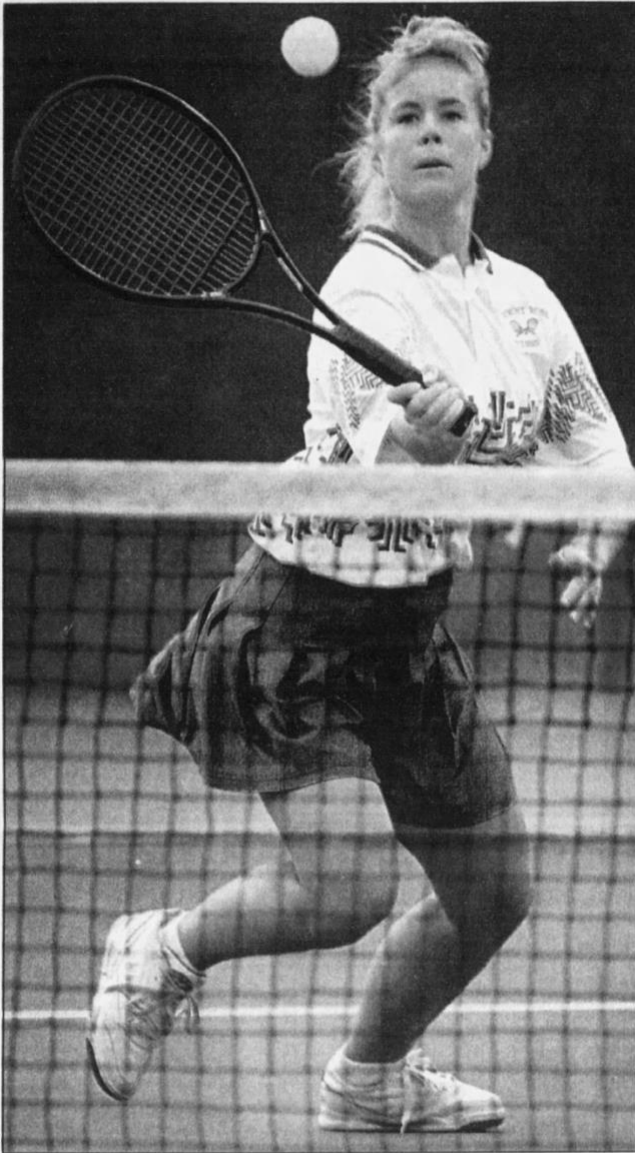

## Little Giants win third straight title

SYLVANIA — To say it was easy might be an understatement. Fremont Ross girls won championships on four of the five courts, and the Little Giants won their third straight Great Lakes League championship.

Dawn Zerman, Kristen Farrell and Andrea Andrews won singles titles at the Courts of Sylvania. In doubles, Casey Schepflin and Dena Schepflin won the first-court title while losing just one game in two matches.

"The confidence I have in my kids came through," Ross coach Sue Badertscher said. "I'm confident in those athletes."

"I was hoping the second doubles team would win too, but Northview has a really good team."

Sara Binau and Alyssa Brickner fell 6-4, 6-3 to Northview's Amy Leiter and Allison Nuco in the finals.

Binau and Brickner missed a chance at a service break trailing 5-4 in the first set, according to Badertscher.

Zerman lost six games on the first-singles court, and Farrell lost five at second singles. Andrews, playing on a sprained ankle, needed three sets to defeat Hallie Heigel of Toledo Whitmer in the finals at No. 3 singles.

Andrews won the first game 6-1, lost the second 6-4 and took the third 6-1.

The Schepflins did not lose a game in the finals at No. 1 doubles.

Ross earned seven points for each victory Tuesday and five more for the runner-up finish to total 33. The Little Giants added that to the 12 points they collected by winning all six dual matches.
