

ROSS THIN-CLADS FACE HARD TESTS

Fremont Ross high's track and field team Monday began preparation for the most important stage of the season in which the Buckeye league meet and district carnival come up on successive week-ends.

Next Friday night, the Little Giants of Coach Whitey Althoff, undefeated in dual competition, travel to Sandusky for the Buckeye classic. Following week-end, Fremont plays host to the district meet. While Sandusky is favored in the Buckeye, Ross stands a strong chance of upsetting the dope.

LOCAL COACH ASSERTS TEAM IN FINE SHAPE

Little Giants Well-Balanced for Cinder Carnival At Sandusky

Fremont Ross high's Purple and White thinlies, undefeated in four dual starts this year, Friday added final touches to preparations for their toughest competition of the year—the annual Buckeye League cinder carnival at Sandusky Saturday afternoon.

With the Sandusky Blue Streaks again boasting a powerful track and field combination, it was predicted the meet would once more evolve into a clash between the charges of Coach Bob Whittaker and the remainder of the field, including Fremont, Tiffin and Findlay.

Close Meet

However, Coach Harold (Whitely) Althoff, of Ross, asserted that the meet probably would be closer than any in recent years, with Sandusky seriously threatened by his own Little Giants.

Fremont is better equipped to dethrone the defending champion Blue Streak team than either Tiffin or Findlay. The fine balance of the Fremont aggregation has been in evidence throughout the season. Althoff states his tracksters are in top shape which means, with exception of two or three events, Sandusky can expect a stiff battle.

Ross has two individual defending champions, Norm Keller, in the mile, and Mernie White, in the pole vault. Sandusky has one, Joe Riedy, in the half mile.

Leading Hopes

Fremont's hopes for first places lies with Pete Erchenbrecher in the century and 220-yard dashes; Jim Spangler in the high hurdles; Keller, in the mile; and the half mile and mile relay teams. The Little Giant half-mile team is defending champion, with three members of that quartet returning to the meet. These are Spangler, Forrest Bingman and Erchenbrecher. The fourth man was Jack Forgeron, whose place this year is taken by Ray Horn. The Ross mile relay team, which last week cracked the school record in 3:40.2, is comprised of Bingman, Clarence Chestnutwood, Burdette Ballard and Frank Kochy.

Althoff also hopes for points from the following: Bob Shaw in the shot-put, discus and high jump; Bud Goodwin in the hurdles; Gale Berger, in the halfmile; Bob Thomson in the discus; and Dick Manahan in the broad jump.

Opposition Listed

Chief opposition for the Purple undoubtedly will be: Talbott, of Tiffin, and Weyer, of Sandusky, in the 100-yard dash; Al L. Gant, of Sandusky, and De Busman, of Tiffin, in the shot-put; Wolfe, of Findlay, and Oglesby, of Sandusky, in the hurdles; Rogers, of Sandusky, and Harrison, of Tiffin, in the mile; Weyer, of Sandusky, and Walcutt, of Tiffin, in the quartermile; Albers and Thomas, of Sandusky, and Walcutt, of Tiffin, in the pole vault; Fleming and Barnett, of Sandusky, and Morrison, of Findlay, in the high jump; Weyer, of Sandusky, and Van Vorhies, of Findlay, in the 220-yard dash; Al L. Gant, of Sandusky, and Frey, of Tiffin, in the discus; and Sandusky in both relays.

Fremont finished second to Sandusky last year. Coach Althoff will leave with his squad at noon Saturday.

Sandusky Continues Reign Despite 7 Purple Firsts

Jim Spangler Paces Little Giants on Water-Logged Track With Firsts in Hurdles, Second in Broad Jump; District Meet is Next

Fremont Ross high's track and field team Monday saw in the scheduled district meet here this weekend a chance to gain revenge for the defeated handed the Little Giants by Sandusky in the Buckeye meet held at Strobel field in Sandusky Saturday.

Despite the seven firsts capped by Ross on the water-logged field of the Blue Streaks, Fremont finished second behind Sandusky with a total of 63 points. The host school, bristling with man-power, rolled up 77 points to win its fourth consecutive Buckeye club title. Tiffin Columbian finished third with 35 points and Findlay last with 16 points.

The erstwhile undefeated Ross squad gave Sandusky a stiff argument all the way, but the strong reserve power of the Blue Streaks took effect towards the end of the meet and shut out all hope of a Purple and White win.

At the end of five events, Fremont and Sandusky were tied at 25, all with Tiffin and Findlay far out of the running. Three of those events, the 100-yard dash, high hurdles and half mile relay, were won by Ross. However, Sandusky managed to stay abreast by scoring heavily in the century, mile run and quarter-mile sprint.

New Record
Only new record being won was in the half-mile run by Joe Riedy, of Sandusky, who won in 2:05.8, bettering his own mark of the previous year of 2:06.

Jim Spangler, veteran Ross trackster, was standout individual performer as he roared to first in both timber chases, tied for second in the broad jump and carried the baton first in the victorious Fremont half-mile relay team. Pete Erchenbrecher, of the Little Giant thunders, also starred, finishing home first in the 100 and 220-yard dashes and running anchor on the 880 relay team.

Other first place winners for Fremont were Leo Shaw, husky sophomore, in the shot, with a winning toss of 46 feet, 10 1/2 inches, and the mile relay team of: Forrest Bingham, Clarence Chestnutwood, Frank Kiechy and Barlette Ballard, coping in 3:36.9. Besides Spangler, Erchenbrecher, Ray Horn and Bingham ran on the half-mile team, which was clocked in 1:34.4.

Wins With Ease
Spangler had little difficulty winning the high hurdles coming home by a comfortable margin over Maurice of Findlay, who won second to get over Bud Goodwin of Ross. Pollock and Maus, both of Sandusky, tied for fourth Spangler's time off was 1:17. The ace hurdler ran away from the field in his heat of the 220 low attacks in 27.7. Oglesby of Sandusky, who won the first heat, was second. Wulfox of Findlay, third, Palmer of Tiffin, fourth and Goodwin fifth.

Dale Berger of Ross took the lead in the half mile at the outset but soon was passed by Riedy and Johnston, of Sandusky. The two Blue Streaks ran a close one-two until the stretch, when Riedy cut loose with a sprint that brought him in first in record time. Berger was third behind Johnston, while Hooser of Tiffin was fourth ahead of Dick Mielke of Ross.

Erchenbrecher was three yards too fast for Sandusky's Weyer in both the century and 220-yard dash. The speedy Little Giant broke the tape in the 100 in 17.7 and in the 220 in 23.4. Talbot of Tiffin was third, Fleming of Sandusky fourth and Van Fleet of Findlay fifth in the 100, while Fleming was third, Van Voorhis of Findlay fourth and Talbot fifth in the 220.

Ballard Fifth
Weyer of Sandusky finished fast to take the quarter-mile in 52.6. Walcott of Tiffin made a strong bid but wavered on the stretch to finish second. Al Gant, Sandusky, was third, Van Voorhis of Findlay fourth, and Ballard of Fremont fifth.

Shaw capped the shot-put on his last toss arching the iron ball almost 47 feet. It was by far the best he ever made by any Ross weight man, but failed to threaten the meet record of 48 feet, 2 1/2 inches. Le Busman of Tiffin was second, Al Gant of Sandusky third, Frey of Tiffin fourth and Anders of Sandusky fifth.

Because of the adverse weather the comparatively poor height of 10 feet won the pole vault. Albers of Sandusky turned the trick. Merrie White, of Ross, Walcott and Hooser of Tiffin all tied for second, and Longworth of Findlay was fifth.

The high jump went to Barnett of Sandusky at 5 feet, 6 inches. Bloom and Walcott, of Tiffin, Fleming of Sandusky and Shaw all tied for second.

Tiffin and Findlay placed in that order behind Fremont's fast stepping half-mile relay team, while Ross high's mile relay quartet came in 25 yards ahead of Sandusky, which staged a close battle with Tiffin for second place. Kochy, running third, ran a fine quarter, building up the Fremont lead to 20 yards.

Rogers Cup
The expected duel between Rogers of Sandusky and Norm Kelley of Ross failed to materialize as the Sandusky's strong finish brought him in only 30 yards ahead of Kelley in 1:41.4. Kollmeier of Sandusky was third, Tolhurst of Ross fourth and Harrison of Findlay fifth.

Ballard of Sandusky bagged 19 feet, one inch to take the broad jump. Spangler and Fleming of Sandusky tied for second, Gundlach of Tiffin was fourth and Frey of Tiffin, fifth.

Frey of Tiffin whirled the discus 104 feet, 7 inches to win that event.

Al L. Gant of Sandusky was second, Shaw third, Le Busman of Tiffin fourth and Bob Thomson of Fremont fifth.

Coach Harold Althoff stated he was "well satisfied" with his team's accomplishment in the Buckeye which he said followed fairly closely to pre-meet form.

Sandusky and Tiffin will invade Harmon field this weekend as Fremont plays host to the annual district meet. Findlay competes in the district at Toledo.
