Fremont Sectional Linksters Won't Travel To State

TOLEDO—The four team representatives from the Fremont golf sectional didn't fare very well in the Toledo district tourney staged at Heatherdowns South Friday.

Fremont Ross, which placed second in the Fremont sectional, had the best aggregate score among the Fremont qualifiers. Coach Charlie Baker's Little Giants placed ninth in the 16-team field with a 337 score.

Clyde, winner of the Fremont sectional, was 14th with a 351. Port Clinton placed third at Fremont and Columbian was fourth.

Toledo Bowsher with a 298 won the district title. Toledo Start was runner-up with a 312. Both teams will qualify for the state meet in Columbus next week.

Also earning berths in the state meet were Steve Mossing, Napoleon, and Don Lowe, Sylvania. Lowe defeated Bowsher's Tom Gilbert in a playoff to take runner-up medalist honors.

Mossing with a 35-35-70 over the par 71 course was the medalist. Lowe and Gilbert scored 72s over the first 18 holes. Lowe won the playoff on the first extra hole.

Kit Kindred was the Ross medalist. He put together a 41-38-79. Bill Moll (38-44-82), Terry Dailey (41-47-88) and Roger Hart (44-44-88) completed the Ross delegation.

Randy Keegan's 78 was low for Clyde. He carded a 40 on the first nine holes and 38 playing the back side. Jeff McMurtrie (43-41-84), Jim Humbert (44-41-85) and Greg Hill (54-50-104) also competed for the Fliers.

Mark Heeman and Dave Haanan paced Port Clinton with an 82 and 86, respectively. Heenan had a pair of 41s. Haanan put together an 44 and 42. Paul Schiefley (96) and Rick Gile (96) completed the Port Clinton foursome.

John Faist, Fremont St. Joe golfer, competed for medalist honors. Faist, a junior, scored an 80 with 40s on both nines.

Bowsher's four entrants all scored in the 70s. Gilbert's 72 led the way. Terry Roehrig (73), Dave Denman (74) and Bill Franklin (79) teamed with Gilbert.

Mark Wallington had Start's best individual score—74. Ted Banash scored a 77, Dick Hense toured the course with 78 strokes and Bruce Bowles carded an 83.
