

# Ross netters third

SANDUSKY — The Ross girls tennis team finished third in the Buckeye Conference tournament held here Saturday,

Findlay easily won the match with 84 points, while Sandusky edged Ross for second 60-58. Elyria was fourth with 54 to round out the top four teams.

Kathy Harman and Sue Shurmer of Ross both lost in the singles finals. Harman upset top seeded Chris Cyb of Admiral King in the opening second singles match 6-3, 6-2. She then bested Kathy Muzio of Lorain 6-4, 6-0, before losing in the finals to Margaret Bellamy of Findlay, 6-1, 6-2.

In third singles, Sue Shurmer of Ross beat Dee Volak of Lorain 7-6, 7-5 and Geri Biddle of Sandusky 6-

3, 2-6, 7-6. She lost in the finals to Ann Baron of Findlay 7-6, 6-1.

Cyndy Malinowski and Gretchen Jefferson of Ross lost their first doubles match to a Mansfield duo 6-3, 6-3, but won in the consolation bracket over Beth Beachy and Linda Kusser of Sandusky 10-8.

In second doubles, Lisa Swedersky and Tammy Homler defeated an Admiral King team 6-2, 6-2, but lost in the finals to Nancy Olsen and Jackie Klepper of Sandusky 6-3, 6-3.

In first singles, Lezlie Grubbs of Ross lost to Margie Mulholland of Elyria 6-0, 6-0 and dropped a consolation match to Cindy Dorsey of Admiral King 10-4.
