### **Ross swimmers dominate Sandusky in opening meet**

The Fremont Ross boys and girl's swim teams dominated most of the events at Tuesday's season-opening meet against Sandusky. The boys won 125-61; the girls 107.5-74.5.

On the girls side, Morgan Waggoner, Meghan Moses, Haley Fisher and Kaity Kelly won the 200 medley relay in 1:56.49. Moses was also first in the 200 individual medley (2:13.90) as well as the 100 breaststroke (1:13.79). She also anchored the first-place 400 freestyle relay team of Alaina Klingman, Morgan Waggoner and Haley Fisher (3:49.66). Fisher was first in the 100 backstroke (1:06.80) and the 500 freestyle (5:30.14). Kelly's 27:07 time in the 50 freestyle was also good for first. Abby Sweeney placed first in the diving event, posting a final score of 185.6.

In the boys events, Tate Williams, Andrew Evans, Nick Hoffman and Trent Williams won the 200 MR in 1:47.89. Evans was first in the 200 free (2:05.37), while Hoffman took first in

the 200 IM (2:14.50) as well as the 100 butterfly (58.57). Hoffman swam the second leg of the first-place 400 free relay team of Trent Williams, Braydyn Klein and Hawk Smith (3:35.65). Klein and Smith also teamed up with Tate Williams and Nick Dorobek on the 200 free relay win (1:41.25). Smith took first in the 500 free in 5:22.07, while Klein won the 50 free (24.68). Trent Williams won the 100 free (50.66) and the 100 backstroke (58.13). Marquis Crawford was the top diver, garnering 219.55 points for the Little Giants.

Ross travels to Perkins Saturday for the NWOAC Relays.

### **Lakota girls lose to Fostoria 50-32**

Bree Long-Meyer had a team-high 11 points, but the Raiders lost 50-32 Tuesday to Fostoria in non-league action.

Lakota also got six points from Destiny Long-Meyer, and five apiece from Sam Miller and Paige Alloway. Alloway had the team's lone triple.

**Ross boys second  
at NWOAC relays,  
girls finish third**

The Fremont Ross boy's swim team racked up 130 points and took second place at Saturday's NWOAC relays.

Nick Dorobek, Will Taylor, Trent Williams and Nickolas Hoffman won the 300-yard butterfly relay in 2:48.83. Braydn Klein, Hawk Smith, Andrew Evans and Tate Williams took first in the 300-yard breaststroke relay in 3:18.12. Tate Williams, Evans, Hoffman and Trent Williams' 3:57.31 time in the 400 medley relay was good for second place. Tate Williams, Hoffman and Taylor swam the 3x100 medley relay in 3:11.05, a third-place finish.

The Little Giants' girls were third place finishers, garnering 122 points.

Haley Fisher, Alaina Klingman, Morgan Waggoner and Meghan Moses won the 800 freestyle relay in 8:21.86. Holly Fisher, Kit Wilson, Waggoner and Moses finished first in the 300 backstroke relay in 3:06.60. Moses also won the 500 freestyle in 5:33.44. Ross took second in the 300 butterfly relay (3:05.35) on a team of Victoria Miller, Libby Jones, Haley Fisher and Waggoner.

Oak Harbor's girls were 7th with 70 points, and the Rockets' boys finished 9th (52).

## **Ross defeats Pirates in pool**

Both the Fremont Ross boys and girls swim teams defeated Perkins in the pool Tuesday. The boys won 98-82, while the girls won 97-88.

Trent Williams was first in the 200 yard freestyle (1:53.08), the 100 backstroke (57.34) and the 200 medley relay (1:46.80). Hawk Smith, Nick Hoffman and Braydn Klein also swam on the 200 medley relay team. Hoffman also finished first in the 200 individual medley (2:10.88) and the 100 butterfly (56.31). Andrew Evans won the 100 breaststroke in 1:05.78 and Marquis Crawford was first the diving competition with 192.65 points.

Meghan Moses won the 200 free in 2:04.74 and the 100 backstroke in 1:01.46. Haley Fisher was first in the 200 IM (2:16.34) and the 100 butterfly (59.99). Morgan Waggoner took first in the 100 free (55.10) and finished the 50 free in 25.21— also good for first. Moses, Fisher, Waggoner and Kaity Kelly were tops in the 200 medley relay (1:56.18). Alaina Klingman swam on the first-place 400 free relay team of Moses, Fisher and Waggoner (3:51.25).

## Hawk goes distance to help score sweep

PORT CLINTON — The 500-yard freestyle race is not typically the first that kids volunteer to swim because of the endurance test it presents.

Morgan Hawk didn't care Thursday as she requested a spot from coach Tina Moses and helped Fremont Ross top Port Clinton 112-105 on the girls side of a non-conference meet. Trent Williams took the 500 freestyle and competed on two first-place relays as the Little Giants' boys won 94-85.

"Nobody requests the 500," Moses said. "She wanted to see what she could do and finished second."

Hawk, a sophomore, hadn't swum the 500

since she was with the Sand Otters.


"I wanted to try something new," she said. "I was proud I went under 7 (at 6:30.80). There was a girl neck-and-neck with me at the end. I heard everybody cheering me on and I made sure that girl didn't beat me."

Hawk was excited to finish third in the 100 breaststroke at 1:22.96 with a little fatigue after swimming the 500 freestyle.

"I'm just trying to improve my time," she said. "I'm working extra hard to make districts. I was close to my season PR. After a hard week with two-a-days and lifting and being sore and tired with a great swim, it shows hard work is paying off."

Haley Fisher won the 200 freestyle, Mor-

gan Waggoner the 200 IM and Meghan Moses the 100 butterfly for Ross's girls. Kortni Lagrou won the 500 freestyle and sophomore Kaity Kelly the 100 backstroke.

"A lot of the younger kids got to swim individual events," Coach Moses said.

Waggoner, Alaina Klingman, Fisher and Moses won the 200 freestyle relay while Fisher, Waggoner, Kelly and Mo-

ses took the 200 medley relay. Fisher, Lagrou, Waggoner and Moses won the 400 freestyle relay.

Trent Williams, freshman Tate Williams, Nickolas Hoffman and Hawk Smith won the 200 medley relay while Trent Williams, Tate Williams, Braydn Klein and freshman Noah Metzker took the 400 freestyle relay. Marquis Crawford won the diving competition.

"We changed the lineup," Ross boys coach Phil Moran said. "We wanted to give younger kids a chance to swim. It left for a good meet. It

came down to the last event. We've been training hard and the younger kids are dropping time. A lot of PRs.

"You have to put them in pressure situations sometime and they were in pressure situations (Thursday)."

Freshman Andrew Evans was second in the 200 IM, freshman Will Taylor was second in the 100 butterfly and 100 breaststroke, and sophomore Nick Dorobek was second in the 100 backstroke.

## **Knight Invitational at the University of Toledo**

Morgan Waggoner, Haley Fisher and Meghan Moses established meet records along with two relays as Fremont Ross's girls swim team finished the Knight Invitational at the University of Toledo in third place.

Waggoner established a meet record to win the 100 backstroke in 58.52 seconds to beat 59.84 while Moses won the 50 freestyle at 23.83 to beat 24.83. Fisher topped 57.87 at 57.12 to win the 100 butterfly and won the 200 IM at 2:09.72 to beat 2:10.35.

Fisher, Alaina Klingman, Waggoner and Moses were second in the 400 freestyle relay but surpassed the previous meet record of 3 minutes, 39.34 seconds at 3:36.93. Mariemont won Saturday at 3:36.52.

Waggoner, Fisher, Kaity Kelly and Moses won the 200 freestyle relay at 1:37.94 for another meet record. The old mark was 1:39.

The Little Giants' boys finished sixth.

Mariemont won the girls portion of the meet while Toledo St. Francis De Sales took the boys.

Fisher was second in the 200 IM, Waggoner second in the 100 butterfly and 100 freestyle, and Moses was second in the 100 backstroke.

Hawk Smith won the 200 IM and Trent Williams the 100 freestyle as Ross's boys were also first.

Freshman Andrew Evans was second in the 200 IM, Williams was second in the 50 freestyle and Smith was second in the 500 freestyle for the Little Giants.
