Ross high's new baseball team, which opens the season Thursday at Port Clinton, drew Toledo DeVilbiss as its first round opponent in the district Class A baseball tournament. Pairings were made yesterday.

Ross and DeVilbiss meet Monday at 4 p.m. at Scott Park in Toledo. Here are the pairings:

Bill Carver's netters handed Toledo Waite a 7-0 lacing on the Indians' courts. DeVilbiss downed the local nine, 14-3, in Toledo.

Jack Baron, Dick Garcia, Ted Houghtaling, Bob Lucas and Larry Harris won singles matches, while Baron teamed with Garcia and Houghtaling with Harris for doubles victories.

Baron didn't lose a game in sweeping two sets, while Houghtaling lost only one and Garcia two. Ross is in action again today against Oak Harbor at Rodger Young Park.

Jake Reber pounded out a triple, double and two singles to lead DeVilbiss to victory over the Ross baseball team.

DeVilbiss jumped off to a 6-0 lead in the first inning. Ross committed nine errors and made only four hits off the slants of three pitchers. Gary Schwartz pitched three innings, being charged with 12 runs. Dean Doren went three innings, giving up two runs and three hits. He fanned four.

Red Miller tripled, Ron Karle doubled and Jim Wolesslagel and Dick Overmyer singled for the only hits by Ross.
