Mitchell Misses Trip To State

SANDUSKY — Barney Leslie breezed to a first place finish in 10:14 Saturday to lead three other Blue Streaks across the line in the first four spots as Sandusky took the district cross country run here.

The Streaks compiled a low score of 17 to win easily. Fostoria was second with 52 points, Bowling Green third with 73, Fremont Ross fourth with 91 and Old Fort last with 154.

Bob Mitchell of Ross just missed a trip to the state meet when he came in eighth. He was seventh all the way but was caught in the last 10 yards by Don Seavers of Sandusky.

Mitchell had a time of 10:51.5 and Seavers 10:51. The first seven qualified for the state meet and the first 10 finishers received gold medals. Dan Ross picked up a silver medal by finishing 17th to get in among the top 20.

Other Fremont runners were Bob Grayson, 21, Hugh Pawsey, 22, Bill Auxter, 23, Mike Terry, 27, and Don Yohe, who ran with stomach cramps, 29. Thirty four runners were entered from the five teams.
