ROSS TANKERS CAPTURE THIRD PLACE HONORS

Sandusky is Winner With Scott Second; Meet Proves Close

With a total of 22 points, Fremont Ross high school swimming team came out of the district meet at Sandusky Saturday with third place honors, bowing to Sandusky and Toledo Scott nataitors.

Sandusky won the event for the second consecutive year, with a total of 36 points. The Scott high team amassed 24 points. Behind Fremont's team came Toledo DeVilbiss, with 15 points, and Toledo Waite with nine marks.

Sherlow, Ross high's star breast stroker, won first place in his specialty, doing the 100 yard event in 1 minute, 14.2 seconds. He beat Samko, of Sandusky; Sandoff, of Toledo Scott; and Donovan, of Toledo Devilbiss.

Merrifield placed second in the 220 yard free style, and Booth took second place in the 100-yard back stroke event. Oxley captured third place honors in the 100-yard free style, and Hasselbach and Serwinski, Ross high's two star divers, were given third and fourth places in the diving contests.

Individuals and relay teams placing in the first four positions will be eligible to enter the state meet at Columbus next Saturday, it was stated.
