Findlay first, Ross second in BC

Dave Fleming was not surprised by the results.

"Findlay is a pretty tough team and today they showed it," said the Fremont Ross golf coach after watching the Trojans beat his Little Giants and five other teams to take the Buckeye Conference golf title Monday at Spring Valley in Elyria.

"We played them close at our course this year," Fleming added. "But that was at our home course. It certainly was different on a neutral course."

Findlay had three golfers on the all-conference first team on its way to the victory. The Trojans scored 311 to 334 for

Ross. Elyria was third at 343.

Jeff Bova led the Trojans with a 73, good for medalist honors. John Whithous and Tom Yeager added 77s for the winners.

The Little Giants placed three golfers on the all-conference second squad. Andy Peterson led the way with a 79, while Shawn Ramirez had 81 and Tom Meade fired an 82.

Rounding out the Buckeye Conference first team were Shane Fischer of Sandusky and John Cortwright of Marion. Fischer shot 75 and Cortwright came in with a 78.

In other golf action in the area Monday, Oak Harbor beat Margaretta 162-173, Bettsville

buried Seneca East 162-181. Fort blitzed Carey 183-203. Huron downed Clyde 168-185.

The Rockets are now overall, 3-5 in the Sandusky Conference with the win over Polar Bears at the Oak Harbor Club. Margaretta is also 3-4 in the league, 4-6 overall.
