Fremont Ross netters shine at tournament

Casey Clark and Rachel Laeng each dropped just two games at the Division I tennis sectional at Sandusky on Thursday as Fremont Ross advanced two doubles teams and a singles player to districts.

Joining Clark and Laeng on the doubles courts for the Little Giants is the duo of Alexis Gedeon and Maddie Kueick. The two were 6-0, 6-0 winners in the second round, before falling in two sets in the third round.

They'll play Saturday, starting at 9 a.m. for seeds three and four at districts, as will singles player Sarah Osborne.

Osborne defeated Oregon Clay's Emma Hillyer 6-1, 7-6 (2) in the first round, then topped Sandusky's Sarah Strohl 6-1, 6-1 in the second.

"Sarah did a wonderful job," Ross coach Lisa Wolfe said. "She is normally a doubles player and more comfortable at that, but is actually our second-best singles players on the team this year. She proved today she can compete on a singles court."

Gedeon, Osborne's normal doubles partner, and Kueick were strong at first Thursday, but struggled in their second match.

"Alexis and Maddie played a great first round to qualify to districts," Wolfe said. "They couldn't get insync, though. They're normal doubles players, but not use to playing with each other."

As for Clark and Laeng, the normal No. 3 and

No. 1 singles players respectively, they'll have a chance for a top-seed at districts.

"They had a good day and had a lot of fun on the court."
