Lady Giants' Tourney Ends at Regional Semis

SANDUSKY – For the second time, in as many seasons, it was a tale of two halves. The Lady Giants stuck around during first half action trailing by only two points 30-28 at the break. Unfortunately, the second half took a dramatic turn when the Lady Bulldogs went on a 10-0 run after Ross closed the gap to 39-35.

By the time the third quarter ended, Olmstead Falls had built a 14-point lead to ruin the Giants chances with the score at 49-35.

The fourth quarter materialize with Olmsted Falls outscoring Fremont 12-4 to put the game away and end Ross' season with a record of 21-5. Olmsted Fall was in the win column for the 14th straight game and carries a 23-3 record into the regional final against Massillon Jackson.

The Lady Bulldogs sank 13 3-point shots during the game action. That, along with cold second half shooting for Ross, sealed Fremont's fate.

Robinson led Ross with 13 points while Carma Johnson and Lyndi Wolf finished with 11 points apiece and Lanae Tucker added six points.

Playing in their final games for Ross were Destiny Robinson, Carma Johnson, Abby Cahill, and Natalia Alejandro. Robinson leaves the Purple Pit as the second leading scorer in Ross history. Over the four season she has electrified and dazzled Little Giant crowds with 1,370 points. Second only to Dawn Zerman's 1403 points during the 1992-1996 seasons.

Over the last four seasons, Robinson, Johnson, Cahill, and Alejandro finish their careers with a 78-21 win-loss record. Mainstays on the varsity floor, they will be remembered for many years to come.

Robinson will continue her career at the University of Toledo while Johnson takes her talents to the University of Findlay. Cahill will continue her stellar volleyball career at DePaul University. Alejandro will continue her career at Terra State. Thanks to all four of these ladies for bringing success to the Fremont Ross Girls Basketball Program.
