ROSS RUNNERS FINISH SECOND

Qualify For State Meet In District Event At Toledo

The Ross high cross-country team qualified for the state high school meet at Delaware Saturday by placing second in the district meet at Toledo last Saturday.

Toledo Libbey won the meet with 49 points while the Little Giant harriers were next with 67, placing ahead of Mansfield, 72 points; Toledo Waite, 76; Toledo Woodward, 101; Toledo DeVilbiss, 146, and Port Clinton, 152.

In qualifying for the big hill and dale run, the Little Giants beat both Mansfield and Waite, the two teams that bested them in dual competition this season.

The first three teams will compete at Delaware, along with other district winners and two of the Fremont runners received gold medals and two bronze medals at Toledo.

Dale Berger, who finished 6th and Druckenmiller, who was 10th, were awarded the gold medals while Davisson and Schlea received the bronze awards for finishing 13 and 17th, respectively. Other members of the Fremont team and their position at the finish were Feighner, 21st; Williamson, 25th and Abney, 41st.

Coach Whitey Althoff said that a practice meet had been arranged with Port Clinton for Tuesday and, with the exception of the state meet, it would conclude the season for his team.
