

# Ross girls ousted; Hoyer advances to state tourney

**BOWLING GREEN** — Ross High School girls tennis players all were eliminated in district

tournament action this weekend at Bowling Green State University.

Fiona Nightingale in singles play won her first match for Ross over Denice Haigh of Sylvania Southview, 7-6 and 6-1. She was then beaten by eventual runner-up Tammy Eisel of Ashland, 6-2 and 6-4. Nightingale beat Eisel in sectional tournament action, but lost to her in the regular season.

Eisel went on to defeat Brooke Bashore of Bowling Green 6-3 and 6-1, but lost in the finals to Linda Hoyer of Port Clinton 6-2 and 6-3.

Hoyer, Eisel and Anna Fariss of Findlay all qualified for the state tournament.

Diane Flickinger and Jenny Goszyk lost their first doubles match for Ross in three sets to district champion Lori Heileman and Betsy Breese of Toledo Bowsher 6-3, 4-6 and 6-3.

Heileman and Breese went on to win the district



title by defeating Darcy Burr and Jane Neumann of Mansfield Malabar, 6-3, 6-4; Penny McNurdy and Kim Harnist of Sylvania Southview, 6-7, 7-5, 6-3, and Mary Lou Abney and Diana Bruzinski of Toledo Rogers, 6-1, 6-1.
