Harding 4th In 5-Team BC Action

Harding cross country runners finished 10-13-15-19-21 in the Buckeye Conference meet at Findlay Tuesday afternoon to total 78 points, taking fourth place in the field of five teams.

Sandusky won the conference championship with 34 points, Findlay finished second with 50, Elyria had 54 for third and Fremont was fifth behind the Prexies with 142 points.

Jerry McKensey led Harding with a 10th place finish in 17:19, Steve Temple ran 17:36 for 13th and Gary Moore was 15th with a time of 17:43.

Rod Leathers placed 19th and Robert Pittman was 21st. Other Harding runners had Doug Smith in 30th place and Larry Moodie was 31st.

Rogers of Sandusky was the individual winner in 16:10, just ahead of Silvers from Elyria who ran 16:14.

The Prexies return to action Saturday, taking part in the Worthington Invitational. Harding will complete its season Tuesday at Fremont in a three-way against the Little Giants and Sandusky.
