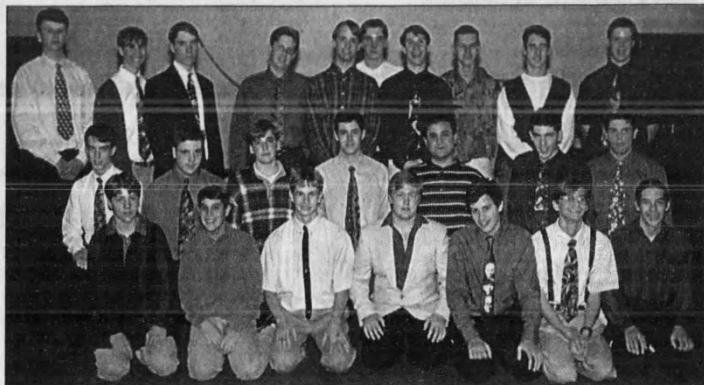

O'Conner, Ickes are top Aqua Giants at Cleveland

Fremont Ross swimmer Molly O'Conner placed in the top 10 in two events, and Mindy Ickes finished in the top 10 in another at the Cleveland State Viking Invitational Saturday.

O'Conner placed 10th in the 50 and 100 freestyle swims after qualifying for the finals with the ninth-best time in each event.

In the finals, O'Conner finished in 25.95 seconds in the 50 free and touched in 56.9 in the 100.

Ickes made the finals in the 100 breaststroke with the eight-best time before placing 10th in the finals with a time of 1:13.54.

O'Conner and Ickes also held down the first and third spots, respectively, on the Aqua Giants' 200 freestyle relay team. They combined with Addie Baker and anchor Annie Mears to place eighth in 1:47.02.

The 200 medley relay placed 13th out of 47 teams for Ross. Mears, Kristyn Warner, Ickes and O'Conner were clocked in at 2:02.7.

Hans Schmidlin finished 25th in the 100 free and 38th in the 50 free for the Ross boys. His times in those events were 52.56 and 24.13.

In diving, Brian Thatcher of Ross placed 12th of 20 divers with 156.5 points.

Two Ross relays also placed in the top 25. The 200 medley of Schmidlin, Andrew Humberger, Erik Luse and Mike Leow was 25th with a time of 1:53.31; Luse, Leow, Humberger and Schmidlin also placed 24th in the 200 free relay in 1:39.56.

Addie Baker and Jennifer Newman won the Coaches Award for the girls and Brian Thatcher won that award for the boys team.

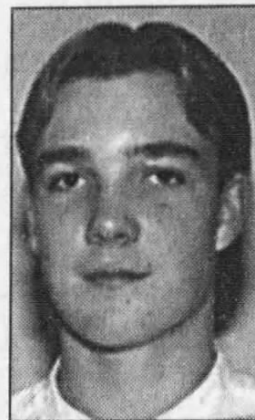
The most improved swimmers were Tricia Tooman for the girls and Jim Straight for the boys.
