

At 130, Latham (32-2) dominated Devon Mezinger of Fremont Ross. Latham, who was a match away from placing at state last year, said he wanted to secure the No. 1 seed for next week. Latham decisioned Mezinger 9-3.

"I feel like I'm doing a good job but I can't be satisfied," said Latham, who also recorded a technical fall and pin yesterday. "I know the state champ is out there working as hard as me."

Latham's teammate, junior Greg Isley, completely controlled Landon Meadows of St. John's in the 189 final. Isley led 9-0 after two periods and cruised to an 11-0 major decision. A state qualifier in 2007, Isley racked up three pins to reach the finals.
