Ross boys, girls swim season to begin

Second year head coach Paul Moran is anticipating improvements for both the Ross boys and girls swim teams for the 1995-96 season.

The girls will return nine letterwinners including seniors Tricia Tooman, Natasha Siebert, Andrea Hasselbach and Kristen Farrell. The junior class returns two letterwinners in Annie Mears and Mindy Ickes. Kristyn Warner, Brandi Oliver and Mollie O'Connor comprise the trio of sophomore letterwinners from last season.

Mears, Ickes and O'Connor competed at the state meet

last season.

Key losses from last season include diver Jennifer Newman and Addie Baker who led the girls swimmers to state competition. Along with Beth Brudzinski and Karen Wonderly the four swimmers scored 96 points at the 1995 sectional meet.

"We should be a better team this year," Moran said. "Our diving will be very inexperienced. Fremont has been spoiled the last few years in diving because of (Leslie) Hasselbach and Newman."

Moran looks for big things from the Ross boys team this season. Eleven letter winners return for the Little Giants from the 1994-95 squad.

Gone are diver Brian Thatcher and four-year letterwinner Hans Geller but leading the way for the returning letterwinners are seniors Josh Redman, Eric Gohring and M. J. Dumminger. Junior letterwinners include Shawn Tooman, Jim Straight, Hans Schmidlin, Erik Luse, Kevin Jackson and Andrew Humberger. A pair of sophomore divers are letterwinners Ryan Newman and Kyle Fisher.

The Little Giants boys and girls teams open their season Wednesday against Calvert and travel to Mansfield on Saturday.

Ross boys, girls open with wins over Mansfield

MANSFIELD — Fremont Ross started the high school swimming and diving season with a pair of victories on Saturday.

The boys defeated Mansfield Senior 118-63 and the Aqua Giants' girls recorded a 103-80 win.

The Ross boys won eight of 12 events and the girls nine of 12.

Hans Schmidlin won twice for Ross, taking the 50-yard freestyle in 23.78 seconds and the 100 backstroke in 1:03.84. He also swam on the winning 200 medley relay and 200 free relays.

Other Ross wins went to Jon Oliver in the butterfly (59.87), Erik Luse in the 100 free (52.43), Brett Spice in the 500 free (5:46.77) and the 400 relay team (3:52.02) of Oliver, Pryde Yost, Ryan Clark and Luse.

Oliver, Andrew Humberger, Luse and Schmidlin comprised the 200 medley relay (1:51.99) while Oliver, Luse, Yost and Schmidlin were on the 200 free relay (1:38.45).

Molly O'Connor, Annie Mears and Mindy Ickes won two events apiece for the Aqua Giants girls.

O'Connor won the 200 free (2:09.02) and 100 free (58.6) while Ickes was first in the 200 individual medley (2:21.83) and the 500 free in 5:34.58. Mears won the 50 free (26.27) and the 100 backstroke (1:11.07).

Ross also won the 200 medley relay (2:03.48) with the team of Mears, Kristyn Warner, Ickes and O'Connor. Warner, O'Connor, Kristen Farrell and Mears were on the winning 200 freestyle relay (1:52.71).

Warner also won the 100 breaststroke in 1:14.28 for Ross, which hosts Galion on Thursday at 5 p.m.

The Fremont Ross girls and boys swim teams kept pace with each other Thursday with each posting wins over Galion at the Fremont Junior High School natatorium.

Both teams are 2-0 after the girls won 62-32 and the boys 70-32.

"The kids swam well," Ross coach Phil Moran summed up the Aqua Giants' efforts succinctly.

So well that the boys won all 11 events.

The girls captured eight. There was no diving.

Three Aqua Giants boys won two events each as well as swimming legs of winning relay teams.

Jon Oliver won the 100 butterfly (59.19 seconds) and 100 backstroke (1:11.48) and swam a leg of the winning 200 medley relay and 200 free relay.

Brett Pryde Yost added firsts in the 50 free (24.89) and the 100 free (55.29) as well

as being on the medley and 200 free relays.

Brett Spicer won the 200 individual medley (2:28.13) and the 500 free (5:47.69) and was on the medley and 400 free relays.

Annie Mears pulled off the same feat for the Ross girls, winning the 50 free (26.14) and the 100 backstroke (1:06.74) and swam on the winning medley and 400 free relays.

Ross swimmers stop Fostoria

The Fremont Ross boys used its depth to nip Fostoria 47-45 while the Ross girls swimmers doubled up on Fostoria 64-32.

Fostoria won nine of the 11 boys events while the Aqua Giants finished 1-2 in the 200 freestyle relay and Hans Schmidlin won the the 20 free (23.32 seconds). Second and third place finishes pulled Ross through.

Eric Luse, Jim Straight, Pryde Yost and Schmidlin comprised the Ross 200 free relay which won in one minutes, 39.84 seconds.

O'Connor, one of five members of the Aqua Giants girls teams to qualify for the state meet, was presented her award by coach Phil Moran.


