54th Annual Little Giant Invitational

The host Fremont Ross boys placed second (106 points) at their home Little Giant Invite on Saturday while the girls took third place (87 points). The St. Joseph Central Catholic girls took fourth (71 points) and the boys finished eighth (18 points) while the Old Fort girls (12 points) and boys (7 points) were both ninth.

The Ross boys were led by the 4x200 Relay team of Jaylen Spencer, Tavarius Simms, Jared Fox and Jalen Sims taking first (1:31.08) while the 4x100 Relay team of Elijah Johnson, T. Simms, J. Sims and Jerardo Eckford also placed first (44.19). Elijah Johnson took first at the 110 Meter Hurdles (14.69) and Tyler Schell was first at the Pole Vault (13-07.00). The 4x400 Relay team of Jared Fox, Spencer, Matt Kuyken and Oliver Ellis added a first place performance as well (3:25.78).

The Ross girls were led by Imani Elkins taking second at the 100 Meter Dash (13.35) while Matallyn Overmyer placed second at the Discus Throw (102-05).

The St. Joseph girls were led by Ava Stepanic taking first at the Long Jump (16-09.25), Olivia Reinhart was first place at the Shot Put (35-02.00) and Brooke Foster took first at the 800 Meter Run (2:21.58). The 4x400 Relay team of Jessica Drown, Chloe Liebold, Miranda Wammes and Foster added a first place performance as well (4:04.72).

The St. Joseph boys did not have any top three finishers.

The Old Fort girls were led by Jenna Clouse taking third place at the 100 Meter Hurdles (17.61) and at the 300 Meter Hurdles (49.48).

The Old Fort boys didn't have anybody finish in the top three.
