

Houghtaling On All-State Cage Team Honorable Mention List

Price Is High At Wooster-School's Best Back-Stroker

Dick Houghtaling, senior Ross high school basketball player, is listed in the "honorable mention" rolls of the class A All-State selections announced today by Associated Press.

Houghtaling, an All-Buckeye choice, was the sparkplug of the Giants' most successful season in 12 years, 16 victories and five defeats.

He is the only Ross player to receive mention. On the first team is Bill Garnes, Findlay's senior six-foot, four-inch performer. Ken McCally, Mansfield's brilliant cager, led the balloting and is a repeater on the first five.

Other first team positions go to Wendell Earley, Canton McKinley; Dave Leggett, New Philadelphia, and Dick Vogeles, Cincinnati Purcell, a 6-7 center. Bill Rogers of Ashland, a Ross opponent of the 1949-50 season, is on the second team.

Area players getting honorable mention include Jim Holz-miller, Sandusky; Ron Shumaker, Fostoria; Dick Hummel, Toledo Central; Dale Porter, Maumee.

A total of 182 of the more than 400 class A players of the state were nominated for All-Ohio consideration.
