

Ross loses in sectional, St. Joe wins

The tournament trail came to an abrupt halt for the Ross girls softball team Tuesday, but it continued on a smooth path for St. Joe.

Ross lost its opening sectional game 15-5 to Galion at the Galion AAA tourney while St. Joe downed Calvert 11-3 in the Class A district semifinals at Bettsville.

At Galion, the Lady Little Giants never really got it going, as the Lady Tigers scored three runs in the first inning and five in the second to go up 8-0. Galion built up a 15-0 lead before Ross finally scored in the sixth inning.

The Lady Tigers, now 11-2, got 10 hits off losing pitcher Kathy Brandt and also took advantage of 10 Ross errors. Ross collected seven hits, two by Celenea Simmons.

Ross dropped to 5-2.

At Bettsville, St. Joe scored in every inning in rolling to the easy victory over the Lady Senecas. The win is St. Joe's 11th out of 12 games this season and third straight over Calvert.

Reenie House and Cheryl Swint led the Lady Streaks to the victory. Each had three hits while Swint drove in four runs
