Oak Harbor medley relay first in district meet; Ross has two seconds

Aqua Giants set three school records

BOWLING GREEN — Oak Harbor won one event and Fremont Ross placed second in two others as the first half of the Northwest Ohio High School Swim Meet was completed Friday at Cooper Pool on the Bowling Green State University campus.

A young Oak Harbor girls medley relay team of Andrea Lajti, Lindsay Lange, Amy Tabbert and Michelle Jenkins won 1 minute, 51.16 seconds. Tabbert is a sophomore and her teammates are freshmen.

Fremont Ross was third in the event with the team of Annie Mears, Kristyn Warner, Mindy Ickes and Molly O'Connor winning in a school record 1:54.18.

Ickes was second in the 200 medley in another school record 2:11.92 and O'Connor tied for second in the 50 free with another Ross record time of 24.59 seconds. Kelly Salinas of Lima Central Catholic posted the same time in the times finals.

On Thursday, Ellyn Vreeland of the Rockets placed second in diving with 388.35 points. Winner Erin Quinn of Sylvania Northview has 450.20.

Unofficially, Napoleon leads the girls standings with Oak Harbor third and Ross fifth.

In the boys events, the best area finish was a fourth in the 50 freestyle by Andy Jenkins of Oak Harbor. He finished in 21.97 seconds. Teammate Aaron Hemminger was fifth in 22 flat.

Swimming in the remaining events begins at noon.

The top three finishers in the swimming events and the top five divers automatically qualify for next weekend's state meet in Canton.

Ross, Oak Harbor sending swimmers to state meet

BOWLING GREEN — Oak Harbor's boys finished third in the Northwest Ohio High School Swimming and Diving Meet completed Saturday at Cooper Pool on the Bowling Green State University campus.

The Rockets had 190 points to trail champion Toledo St. Francis DeSales, who amassed 501 points, and Sandusky Perkins with 197. Fremont Ross finished 11th with 79 points.

A pair of Great Lakes League team dominated the girls as Napoleon took first with 265 points, and Sylvania Northview was second with 232. Oak Harbor was fifth with 162 and Ross sixth with 148½.

The Oak Harbor boys 200-meter freestyle relay finished second Saturday. Nick Lange, Andy Jenkins, Aaron Hemminger and Ron Lajti finished in 1:28.7.

In girls events Saturday, Lindsay Lange of Oak Harbor won the 100 breaststroke in a district record 1:05.91. Mindy Ickes of Ross was second in the event in a school record 1:07.78.

Molly O'Connor of Ross was third in the 100 freestyle in 53.33 seconds, also a school record. Friday, O'Connor qualified for the state meet in the 50 freestyle. Ickes will also swim two individual events at the state meet, qualifying Friday in the 200 individual medley.

The Aqua Giants' 200 freestyle relay team, fourth Saturday, qualified as an at-large entry into the state meet. The team of Annie Mears, Jenny Schaaf, Ickes and O'Connor finished the district race in a school record 1:41.66.

The Oak Harbor girls 200 freestyle relay squad also qualified as an at-large entrant after a fifth-place finish Saturday in 1:41.78. The team is comprised of Andrea Lajti, Melissa Jenkins, Lange and Amy Tabbert.

The Rockets' boys 400 freestyle relay team of Cory Barrett, Andy Jenkins, Geir Lindahl and Aaron Hemminger finished fourth Saturday in 3:18.91 but qualified for the state meet on the at-large basis.

The at-large entries were determined Sunday by comparing times with other district meets.
