FREMONT ENTERED IN X-COUNTRY VIE

DELAWARE, O., Nov. 2.—*AP*—Thirteen schools fight it out for honors in the 13th annual Ohio high school cross country meet here today.

Akron South, winner of last year's meet, will defend her title against Akron North, Springfield, Toledo Libbey, Akron East, Cincinnati Hughes, Cleveland Lincoln, Greenfield, Toledo DeVilbiss, Cleveland J. F. Rhodes, Lakewood, Cleveland John Adams, Cuyahoga Falls, Enon, Fremont Ross, Mason, Monroe and St. Clairsville.
