

King Takes 5-0 Decision

Admirals Drop Ross In Buckeye Finale

VERMILION—Admiral King high school is the 1970 Buckeye Conference baseball champion.

The Admirals put together four runs in the fourth inning and another in the seventh to blank Fremont Ross, 5-0, in the championship game Friday afternoon.

Admiral King pitcher Paul Salyer limited the Little Giants to three hits—singles by Tom Brough, Al Davis and Paul Miller.

"We just tightened up," Ross mentor Tom Dorman said. "It wasn't that our kids weren't high for this game because they were. But we had a lot of youngsters in there."

"In the fourth inning, Jim Fausey just tightened up. But that was one reason I started him. I knew he would give us everything he had. I couldn't very well take him out of the game in that spot—he has been in jams like that before this season and got out of them."

Admiral King put together three hits to score its four runs in the fourth. Fausey walked the first two batters before getting an out with a fielder's choice. But Rich Roman singled through the

in their last two outings. Huron beat Ross 5-0 Tuesday night.

Ross finished its season with a 9-11 report card. A game with Clyde which was postponed earlier this week will not be replayed.

"It was a long season," Dorman said. "We played our first two games of the Buckeye 14 days ago. The kids were ready to play the championship game last Friday but then we had to wait. With this young a club that isn't good."
