District Track Meet Begins At B.G. Today

Ross high school's track team turned to the district meet at Bowling Green today after polishing off Tiffin Columbian in a dual meet there yesterday, 72-46. It was the third win in five dual matches for the Giants, who whipped Bellevue and Sandusky before toppling Columbian.

Bowling Green and Fostoria were the teams to beat Ross in dual engagements this year. The district meet's preliminaries are slated for today, the finals coming Saturday.

Dick Willey won both hurdle events against Columbian, while Charlie Glover won the broad jump, tied for first in the 100-yard dash, anchored the winning 880-yard relay team and placed third in the 220-yard dash.

Lee Wins 220

The 220 went to Ross high's Tom Lee in the fine time of 23.6 seconds. Jerome Surratt, sophomore, was second.

John Allen and Bob Biggs continued their winning ways in the field events. Allen captured the shot put, while Biggs gave the discus its longest throw.

Billy Smith, blond senior, won the pole vault. Columbian's mile relay team, winner of the Buckeye League race, had its hands full and barely nosed out the Ross racers.

Bob Biggs qualified for the state finals by placing second in the district track tournament at Bowling Green yesterday.

The Ross track performer was second in the discus throw.

Toledo Libbey had 17 points to take the lead at the end of the first day of competition. Bowling Green got six points for runner-up while Ross had five points.

In class B, Elmore led with 13 points. Clyde, Ada and Troy trailed with six each.

Clyde qualifiers were Bob Fox in the 100 and 220-yard dashes, and Lester Hawk in the 100. Fox also won the broad jmp, going 20 feet, one and one-quarter inches. Larry Meek and Keegan qualified in the low hurdles.
