

2016 DIVISION I DISTRICT CHAMPIONSHIPS

SWIMMING

The Fremont Ross girls swim team made history Saturday.

The Lady Giants won the first district championship in the program's history at Bowling Green State University. Ross claimed the title by narrowly edging out Strongsville 241.5 to 238.5.

The top two swimmers in each event qualified to the state championships, which will be held Wednesday through Saturday in Canton. The Lady Giants will have several representatives.

Morgan Waggoner and Meghan Moses finished first and second in the 50-yard freestyle with times of 23.19 and 23.6, respectively. Waggoner also won the 100 freestyle in 50.98, while Moses finished third at 52.01.

Oliva DeRodes took a second-place finish in the 200 freestyle with a time of 1:54.35.

DeRodes, Waggoner and Moses took part in the 400 freestyle relay, along with MaKennah Fitzgerald, finishing first in a time of 3:29.97.

DeRodes, Anne Marie Moses, Kaity Kelly and Meghan Moses also had a championship performance in the 200 freestyle relay, winning in a time of 1:37.09.

In the boys events, Trent Williams qualified in a pair of events, the 50 and 100 freestyles. He took second in both races, finishing in 21.34 seconds and 46.64, respectively.

Andrew Evens will also be making the trip to Canton having finished second in the 100 breaststroke in 58.14 seconds.
