MANSFIELD — Coach Mal Mackey's Ross high wrestling brought home the team trophy and also four individual first place trophies from here Thursday where the Little Giant grapplers captured a four-team tournament.

Ross finished with 80 points, Ashland with 72, Mansfield Madison 67 and host Mansfield 52.

Individual champions for Fremont were Larry Kelly in the 112-pound weight class, Tom Auxter in the 120-class, Harry Quackenbush in the 127-class and Ed For-

gatsch in the 175-class.

Kelly decisioned Rick Hocker of Mansfield and Steve Doerrer of Ashland.

Auxter pinned Easter McNeil of Mansfield, 24 seconds of the second round, then decisioned Glenn Barnes of Ashland.

Quackenbush won on two pins, nailing Roy Jackson of Mansfield at 1:39 of the first round and Dan Hoover of Ashland at 1:02 of the second.

Forgatsch pinned Roy Johnson of Ashland at 1:47 of the first, then decisioned Harold Phillips of Mansfield.
