Little Giant Aseltine shoots 165

Senior Andrew Aseltine of Fremont Ross finished the Division I state golf tournament in 19th place.

"The weather was terrible," Little Giant coach Mark Miesle said. "Of the 36 holes, 30 were played in the rain. It was bad luck for everyone so scores weren't as good as hoped."

Aseltine carded an 84 (40-44) on Friday and an 81 (41-40) on Saturday for a 165.

Miesle enjoyed coaching Aseltine.

"It's been fantastic," he said. "He did nothing but try his best. There's nothing else I could have possibly asked him to do."

Miesle said Aseltine helped set a standard at Ross.

"It will take somebody who's extremely dedicated to the game," Miesle said of someone approaching Aseltine's accomplishments. "It can be done but it will take a dedicated young man that always strives to get better."
