Ross Second In League Golf Match

Ross high's golf foursome of Bob Berry, Jerry Smith, Jim Stahl and Curt Hasselbach finished second to record - breaking Sandusky in the Buckeye Conference golf meet.

The Little Giants totaled 354 but were 35 strokes behind the Streaks who had 319, shaving a stroke off the record they set a year ago to win the conference title.

Medalist of the meet was Gene Boni of Sandusky with 38-38—76. The three other Streak golfers were Nick Gordon, 37-41—78; Nick Mazza, 41-41—82; and Dale Pelz, 41-42—83.

Findlay finished third with 359, Marion fourth with 371 and Elyria fifth with 390.

Ross' scores were Berry, 41-46—87; Smith, 49-46—95; Stahl, 42-41—83; and Hasselbach, 40-49—89.

Next Tuesday, Ross has a match with Tiffin Calvert which will serve as a tune-up for the district next Friday at Chippewa golf course in Toledo.
