Ross High Harriers Place 6th At BGSU

With more than 70 entrants in the running and 13 schools represented, Coach Harold Schahet's Ross high school cross country team placed sixth Saturday in the district meet at Bowling Green State university.

Al Price, who has paced Ross' squad over the season, earned fourth place among all the entrants. Others from Ross who entered came up with the following places: Dwane Hack, 15; Marvin Hines, 36; Al Hetrick, 39; Mark Walter, 42; Jack Lee, 43; and Walter Hurse, 53.

Each school was allowed to start seven runners, but only the top five from the schools were counted in the final tallies. Because Price finished among the top 10 individual runners, he qualified for the state meet Saturday at Columbus.

The two top schools in the meet will go to state meet. These included winner Marion Harding with 52 points and runnerup Lima Central with 64.

Third went to Ashland; 4. Toledo Whitmer; and 5. Mansfield.

The Ross season of nine meets ended with six wins and three losses for Coach Schahet's squad.
