Ross Misses in CC

UPPER SANDUSKY — Fremont Ross' premier distance runner Mark Hoffman missed an individual qualifying position to Class AA District cross country competition by two places here Saturday and that was as close as the Little Giants came in the sectional event.

Galion won the team tally with 54 points to Lima Shawnee's 82 and 100 for Tiffin Columbian. The trio will battle for District honors Saturday in Toledo.

Hoffman covered the two-mile course in 10:39 for 21st place. Ross finished in seventh place with 191 points behind Ashland (112), Findlay (151) and Marion

Harding (175) which also missed qualifying berths.

More than 100 runners from 16 schools raced to extend their cross country season which culminates Nov. 4 at Columbus.
