# Mansfield Defeats Ross In Tourney

## Fremont Takes 12-1

### Defeat In Sectional

Running into a rugged competitor in Mansfield high's baseball team, Ross high lost a 12-1 game Tuesday on the winner's field and dropped out of further contention in the sectional playoffs leading to state championship.

Woody Hightower, on the hill for Mansfield, held the Little Giants to two hits over the distance with Al Price and Jim Houghtaling getting the bingles. Price labeled out a double in his swat.

Ross went into a 1-0 momentary lead in the top of the second, then Mansfield returned with a four run explosion in the bottom of the frame and that was the start of the victory for the host team.

Larry Miller started on the hill for Ross and was relieved in the third with Al Price coming in for the remainder of the contest.

Price's double scored Glen Haas with Ross' only marker.

The big inning for Mansfield was in the fifth when six runs were scored to make the going just a bit too rough for Ross in the following two innings that remained.

After Houghtaling collected his single in the fourth, Hightower settled down and held Ross hitless and scoreless the rest of the way in the encounter. The Mansfield hurler struck out 10 while Miller had two and Price three along the line.

Fremont made two double plays in the game.
