Aseltine medalist, Ross takes second at GBC meet

Andrew Aseltine was medalist with a 2-under 69 to capture Greater Buckeye Conference player of the year honors as Fremont Ross finished the GBC Championship in second place at 313 on Tuesday.

Findlay won the event with a 302, their second conference title in a row.

"I'm thrilled for Andrew and Scott (King)," said Ross coach Mark Miesle. "One of Andrew's goals at the beginning of the year was GBC player of the year, which he achieved. I'm very excited with Scott making first-team after his consistent play all year. It's fantastic he was honored first team."

King added a 77 to make the all-tournament team and Spencer Schabel carded a 78 for the Little Giants. Miesle said Schabel could be key as the season winds down.

"I'm not disappointed with the 313," Miesle said. "Marion Country Club played very tough (Tuesday). The course was wet with the rain and it was windy. Findlay just got us with their consistency."

Ross plays in sectionals at Tiffin Mohawk Country Club Oct. 6 and 8.

"I feel very good," Miesle said. "We can still shave a few shots here and there. It's good it's at Mohawk. The guys have played there and should be familiar with the course. We won't be caught off guard. We know it pretty well."
