##### Ross boys 2nd, girls 3rd

OREGON — Two Fremont Ross girls and two Little Giant boys runners earned first-team All Great Lakes League honors Saturday during the GLL Championships at Pearson Park.

The Ross boys finished second to Whitmer, while the girls managed third place behind Whitmer and Napoleon.

Whitmer won the boys race with 34 points to Ross's 60. The Whitmer girls scored 40 points to get past Napoleon (62) and Ross (66).

Stacy Hall led all Little Giants by placing third in the girls race with a time of 20:10. She joined teammate Megan Neeley on the first team. Neeley came in sixth

with a 20:36.<sup>N</sup>

Wendy Farrell of Ross claimed second-team honors by finishing 10th in 20:59. Alyssa Bowerman snatched honorable mention by placing 21st in 21:47. Lindsay Swope rounded out the scoring, with a 22:33, good for 31st place.

Both the girls' times were personal bests.

"It was a total team improvement," Ross head coach Cathy Esposito said. "We had three girls in the 20s, which is a good sign. Our number four and five runners really stepped up."

Nathan Bowen ran an inspired race to finish fifth in 17:10 and join Ross's Jay Ohms (seventh, 17:17) on the first team All-GLL.

Derek Hill placed 15th in 17:50, Josh Ohms was 16th in 18:02; and Carl Sabinas was 17th in 18:06.

"They really competed well with Whitmer," Esposito said of the boys. "They just had too much for us. It was a great way for us to go into districts, where I think we'll fare well."
