
**Fremont Ross 54, Toledo Whitmer 51 (OT)**

Ross plays Perrysburg at 1 p.m. Saturday at Lake.

Ahlia Simms had 11 points and Rachel Gore nine for the Little Giants. Gore canned a 3-pointer in overtime and Olivia Baptista made 4 of 4 free throws, including two for the final margin with 1.6 seconds left.

Ross trailed 22-17 at the half and 34-23 after three quarters. It scored 22 points in the fourth quarter for a 45-45 tie after regulation.
