Atkins To Represent Ross In 3 State Track Events; Elmore's Reynolds Advances

Bob Atkins will represent the Fremont Ross high track team in the Class AA state track and field finals at Columbus this weekend in the 100, 220 and 440 yard dashes.

In Class A, Elmore high will have a state representative in Bill Reynolds, high hurdler.

Atkins placed second in all three dash events at the District track and field meet at Bowling Green State university Saturday.

Reynolds took a first place in the 120-yard high hurdles in 16.4 seconds.

Had Set Record

Fremont's Atkins, a senior, who set a new District record in the 440 in Friday's preliminaries with a time of 48.6 and placed first of all qualifiers in the 220 with a time of 22.1, had to settle for runnerup spots Saturday in the 100-yard dash won by a Lima Senior high trackman in 10.2 seconds, in the 220 won by Odell Barry of Toledo Scott in 22.3 seconds and in the 440 won by Larry

Copeland of Lima Senior in 50 seconds flat.

Winner and runnerup in each event in the District advances to the state finals this weekend.

Coach John Ihnat, Ross track pilot, said Atkins did not appear as sharp Saturday as he did in the prelims Friday.

"Probably the District track finals and Junior-Senior Prom don't mix," Ihnat said. Atkins attended the Prom Friday night.

"Anyway, Atkins will get his chance to win a first place in the state meet," Ihnat opined. "I think Bob can win the 440 if he does 49.5 or better and under 22 seconds in the 220. And I believe he is capable of achieving both times."

Atkins was barely nipped in both the 100 and 440 in the District. In fact, Ihnat thought his track ace could have been declared a tie winner in the 100.

Ross Team Fifth

Ross tied for fifth in the team score in Class AA with 13 points. Lima Senior was an easy winner with 56 points. Clyde had 3½ points and Oak Harbor 2. Besides Atkins' 12 points for Ross, Gene Nitschke picked up a point for a fifth place in the discus. Jim Bolinger of Clyde tied for third in the pole vault and Larry Fredericks of Clyde was fourth in the 880-yard run. Roger Lorensen of Oak Harbor was fourth in the discus toss.

For Elmore in Class A, Reynolds win the high hurdles, the Elmore 880 relay team (B. Avers, LaBierce, Haar, C. Avers) took a third, Bill Avers was third in the 220-dash and Elmore fifth in the mile relay (Haar, Brandon, C. Avers, LaBierce). Elmore had 13 points for seventh place in Class A which was won by Otsego with 31½ points.
