## **Swimming: Ross girls finish as district runners-up**

CLEVELAND — Meghan Moses won the district crown in the 50-yard freestyle (23.91 seconds), while Morgan Waggoner won the 100 fly (57.00) and Haley Fisher won the 200 IM (2:06.03) as Fremont Ross finished as district runners-up to Strongsville at Saturday's Division I district swim competition at Cleveland State University's Busbey Natatorium.

Moses also anchored the winning 200 and 400 free relays as the Little Giants qualified four girls to the Division I state swim meet, which will start Friday with prelims at Canton's CT. Branin Natatorium.

Moses, a sophomore, will be the fifth seed in the 50 free and 18th seed in the 100 free. Waggoner, another sophomore, will be the eighth seed in the 100 fly and added another automatic qualification in the 100 backstroke where she was district runner-up with a time of 57.68 seconds. She'll be the 12th seed.

Fisher, a junior, will be the 10th seed in the 200 IM. She just missed adding the 500 free to her list, finishing third with a time of 5:10.56—0.49 seconds behind the final at-large spot.

Senior Megan Hawk joined the three on the winning 200 free relay (1:35.91) and first-place 400 free relay (3:31.12). Those relays will be seeded third and fourth respectively.

Hawk was seventh in both 100 and 200 free events.

On the boys side, Ross' Trent Williams placed second in the 100 backstroke to earn an automatic qualification. The sophomore will be the boys lone representative and swim as the 19th seed.

Ross' Nickolas Hoffman was a little over a second off qualifying in the boys 100 fly, placing seventh at districts. He was 10th in the boys 200 IM.
