Bob Qualifies For State Finals

Bob Biggs won the discus throw in the district track and field meet at Bowling Green State University yesterday, but the husky Ross high school senior didn't come up to his record-breaking heave of Monday.

Biggs hoped to set a record after he threw the discus 150 feet 9½ inches in the Buckeye League meet, but a damp day plus a faulty take-off nullified his chances.

However, his toss of 137 feet, 9 inches was good enough to win him first place. He was the only Ross boy who qualified for the state finals at Columbus next week-end.

The record for a district meet is 148 feet, 9 inches, held by Jack Pfeiffer of Toledo DeVilbiss since 1944.
