# Running regionals today

**Fremont Ross** and **Bellevue** will have both its boys and girls cross country teams vying for berths in the state final meet when they run in today's regional meets at Hedges Park in Tiffin.

The boys teams from **Old Fort** and **Gibsonburg** get the day started when they vie in the Division III, Region 10 meet at 11:05 a.m. The Div. II, Reg. 6 boys race, featuring **Bellevue** and **Lakota** begins at 11:50 a.m. At 12:35 p.m., the Little Giants boys team will race in the Div. I, Region 2 meet.

**Fremont St. Joseph** and **Woodmore** will be in the Div. III, Region 10 girls race, scheduled to begin at 1:20 p.m. **Bellevue** and **Clyde** are in the Div. II, Region 6 competition, which has as 2:05 p.m. start. **Ross's** girls run at 2:50 p.m. in the Div. I, Region 2 race.

# Eleven runners qualify for state

Travis leads 'Cats in regional

TIFFIN — The Woodmore girls cross country team is headed to Columbus for Saturday's state cross country championships.

The runners earned the right to compete with Ohio's best by finishing third Saturday at the Division III regional meet which took place at Hedges-Boyer Park in Tiffin. Seneca East placed first and Liberty Benton second.

Sophomore Lindsay Travis placed 11th with a time of 19:46 over the 3.1-mile course, while

teammates Amanda Roadarmel (20:10), Mandy Opfer (20:43), Connie Camp (20:51) and Cara Moellman (21:06), placed 17th, 25th, 29th, and 39th respectively.

"Lindsay (Travis) hung in there," head coach Alicia Wollmering said. "It may not have been one of her better races, but she will be well rested this week and ready to go (at state)." Travis had won the district meet a week earlier at Terra Community College, breaking
